(3+ years of High School experience)

- Pass annual NCAA Lacrosse Rules Certification
- Provided certification results to Training Coordinator
- Attend and support follow-up Zoom
- Continue re-education and training through USA Lacrosse website
- Participation in Training Exercises from experience members is expected
- Officials interested in advancing should complete the USA Lacrosse Certification Process for desired level.
